Magicus the Bunny

Finished Sizes: 3 1/2 inches tall

HELLO CROCHETER!

Do you believe in magic? We do!! Magicus the Bunny is ready to disappear on the magician top hat and make magic tricks with you. Let the magic begin!!

MATERIALS:

- 1- Worsted weight yarn in black and blue color
- 2- Size G (4 mm) crochet hook
- 3- Tapestry needle
- 4- Stitch marker

ABBREVIATIONS:

ch: chain

sc: single crochet

dec: single crochet decrease

R: round

**rep: repeat stitches between the asterisks

st(s): stitch(es)

(): total number of stitches in a round



HOW TO...

WORKING INTO THE FRONT LOOP ONLY

All stitches are worked in both loops of the stitch, unless otherwise directed.



1. Look for the V's across the top of the stitches.



2. Insert the hook underneath the front loop of each V.

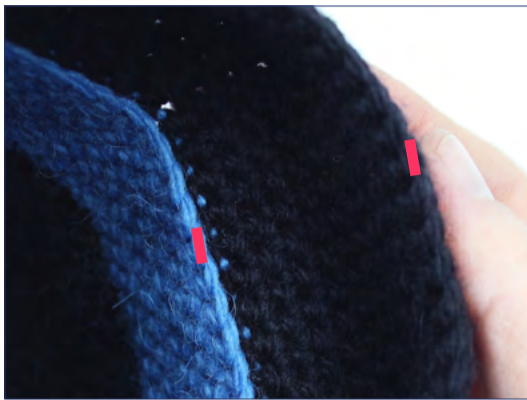


3. Make a simple crochet. Continue working through the front loop all around the hat.



4. You will use the back loops later to join the hat brim together.

JOIN THE HAT BRIM TOGETHER



1. Let's join both sides of the hat brim together, using the back loop of every stitch you left in the beginning of the hat brim and the stitches of last row worked.



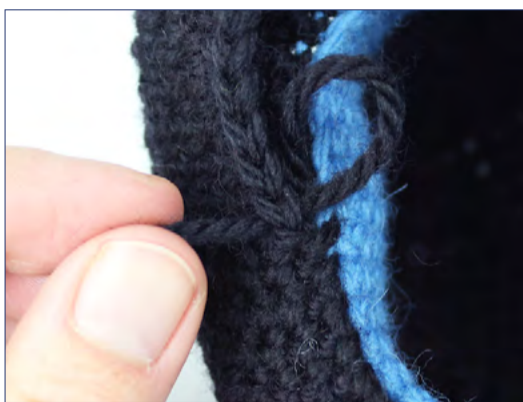
2. Flatten the hat brim.



3. Now you have the corresponding stitches of both hat brim sides together.



4. Thread a yarn needle with the long black yarn end you left for sewing. Insert the needle through the loop of the corresponding stitches on both hat brim sides.



5. Draw the yarn all the way through, but do not pull it overly tight.



6. Repeat steps 4 and 5 for each stitch around the two sides of the hat brim. Fasten off and weave in ends. This is the result!

MAGICUS THE BUNNY

MAGICIAN TOP HAT

Using G hook and black yarn,

R1: Ch 2, 6 sc in second ch from hook.

R2: Sc 2 in each sc around. (12 sts)

R3: *Sc 1, 2 sc in next sc*, rep 6 times. (18 sts)

R4: *Sc 2, 2 sc in next sc*, rep 6 times. (24 sts)

R5: *Sc 3, 2 sc in next sc*, rep 6 times. (30 sts)

R6: *Sc 4, 2 sc in next sc*, rep 6 times. (36 sts)

R7: *Sc 5, 2 sc in next sc*, rep 6 times. (42 sts)

R8: *Sc 6, 2 sc in next sc*, rep 6 times. (48 sts)

R9: *Sc 7, 2 sc in next sc*, rep 6 times. (54 sts)

R10-R20: Sc 54.

Change to blue yarn,

R21-R25: Sc 54.

Change to black yarn,

Working into the front loop only (if you need help see **page 3**),

R26: Sc 54.

Working in both loops,

R27: *Sc 8, 2 sc in next sc*, rep 6 times. (60 sts)

R28: *Sc 9, 2 sc in next sc*, rep 6 times. (66 sts)

R29: *Sc 10, 2 sc in next sc*, rep 6 times (72 sts)

R30: *Sc 11, 2 sc in next sc*, rep 6 times (78 sts)

R31: Sc 78.

R32: *Sc 11, dec 1*, rep 6 times. (72 sts)

R33: *Sc 10, dec 1*, rep 6 times. (66 sts)

R34: *Sc 9, dec 1*, rep 6 times. (60 sts)

R35: *Sc 8, dec 1*, rep 6 times. (54 sts)

Fasten off, leaving long tail for sewing.

Join both sides of the hat brim together, using the back loop you left on round 26 (where you made the color change. If you need help see **page 4**).
